1 The staircase hall at Heale House is lit with *plaffoniers* (page 75). Jamb's 'Apsley' hanging lantern (£5,040), a modern reboot of the popular Victorian design, is edged with reeded bands and suspended from linked twist-moulded dowels. Ring 020 7730 2122, or visit jamb.co.uk.



2 The plaster ceilings at Heale House feature in the 1996 film of *The Portrait of a Lady* (page 72). There was no silver-screen moment for this ceiling, cornice, pediment and columns made by George Jackson for a Regent's Park house, but it could have a role in yours, from £30,000. 3 A toile-de-jouy-papered bedroom, like the one at Heale (page 80), tops many *Wolf* wish lists, and the floral print covering the bedside tables would be in the mix too. 'Seville' from Bernard Thorp costs £142.24 per m. Ring 020 7376 3640, or visit bernardthorp.com.



4 Neisha Crosland's orange 'Caterpillar Leaf' wallpaper (£76 per 10m roll) sings against the panelling on the Rasches' stairs (page 74). The meadow green or black/cream versions would work well somewhere lighter and brighter. Ring 020 7259 7280, or visit turnellandgigon.com.



5 Frances Rasch sought the expert advice of Penny Morrison for the dining room, who wisely suggested her own 'Haveli'
